Both Palm Beach County and the Juno Isles Covenants do not allow boats, trailers, trucks, or other vehicles to be parked on the swales or in a way that blocks the sidewalk, even in your own driveway. Please be considerate of your neighbors. It's one thing to wash off your boat after a fun day on the water but quite another to leave it or any other vehicle on the swale or blocking the sidewalk overnight.

Speaking of swales, it's important to be careful if you plant any trees in the

swale in front of your house. Those trees may look cute to you but they can not be allowed to block a driver's line of sight at a corner or impeded people walking on the sidewalks.
