FPL TO TRIM VEGETATION NEAR POWER LINES

Due to recent and ongoing power outages affecting 79 homes within Juno Isles, FPL will have trimming crews in the area to address any vegetation in contact with the power lines on this grid. Additionally, they will be inspecting the lines and related equipment, replacing any components that could be contributing to power outages.

NEW FEMA FLOOD ZONE MAPS

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has released updated flood zone maps. Consequently, thousands of more Palm Beach County residents have been added to high-risk flood zones (aka Special Flood High Hazard Areas) in the eastern region.

New [FEMA flood maps](#) are set to take effect later this year, which may force thousands of residents to buy federal flood insurance.

To help with the process, Palm Beach County officials are

holding meetings in September so the public can ask questions about the changes.

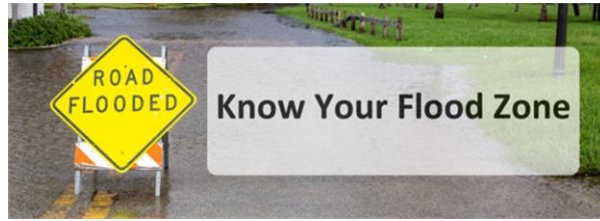
