Dear Juno Isles Resident,

During the last several years the Board of Directors has made almost all communication with the residents by electronic means through our website, www.junoisles.org, and by sending out e-mails to over 85% of the residents. This saves us money and allows us to get information out much faster. As one of the 42 households of our community of 337 homes that does not have an e-mail address on file for us to use to communicate current events and important information, I wanted to write to you for three main reasons.

The **first** is to make sure you know where important information about your community is, so you can be better informed. The Juno Isles Civic Association website at www.junoisles.org contains information about our community including: the agenda and minutes from meetings of the Board of Directors, architectural approval forms, information on activities including the Annual Meeting on November 14th, the Halloween and Christmas Holiday Lights contests, and our annual picnic-community participation get together on December 7th.

Of special note, **the homepage of the website also has a direct link to the [covenants](#) that spells out the rules for our community.**

Secondly, I would like to request that you provide us with an email address so we can provide information about what is happening in Juno Isles. Please call our phone number 561- 354-9120 to leave a message or send an e-mail to us at jica@junoisles.org with your e-mail. We use e-mail addresses to keep residents informed of important events including notification of meetings, information on FPL tree trimming activities, new federal flood maps that may require some residents to get federal flood insurance and other timely information. If you don't use email, perhaps you have a family member or close friend that could receive these e-mails for you and be your "eyes and ears". Everyone still receives the official package of materials, including a ballot, for the Annual meeting mailed to you a month before the meeting.

Finally, I would like to encourage you to become more involved with our community. While we always welcome residents to serve on the Board of Directors, there are many other ways that you could become more involved.
